TRAINING COURSE IN CPP30115 CERTIFICATE III IN URBAN PEST MANAGEMENT

To ensure this course proceeds, we will need a minimum of 12 candidates. The investment will be \$2,100.

To enrol in this Course the candidate must have successfully completed CPPPMT3006 Manage pests by applying pesticides. Candidates can undertake the course CPPPMT3006 Manage Pests by Applying Pesticides and Certificate III in Urban Pest Management concurrently; however candidates must enrol in both courses.

To achieve the Certificate III in Urban Pest Management, the candidate must demonstrate competency in 13 units of competency; 9 core units and 4 elective units. The elective units offered in this course are highlighted below.

The training and assessment in this presentation of the Certificate III Course is offered for the set investment of \$2,100. It will include all core units and elective units shaded in blue below and one round of assessments. Candidates deemed not yet competent may incur additional fees for reassessment.

Face to face training 1 night per week for approximately 3 hours per night for 20 weeks, unless otherwise agreed by all candidates. Plus, up to three practical training and assessment sessions on site. Please note that each week, candidates will need at least six to nine hours each week to undertake workplace projects and other assessments outside of class time. Additional and/or alternative electives can be chosen from the two groups listed; however these are not included in this presentation of the course. An additional investment is required and subject to demand.
