Please note that the investment includes one practical assessment only. Additional charges apply for reassessment/s.

Western Australian participants must be at least 18 years of age and be medically fit and are required by the Department of Health (WA) to submit a medical certificate and a First Aid Certificate (including Resuscitation) – HLTAID003 when applying for their licence.
