COURSE CONTENT

This course covers the outcomes required to apply pesticides safely and efficiently and according to directions on manufacturers' labels in order to manage non-timber pests in residential, commercial and industrial premises. It covers assessing the nature and extent of the pest and pest activity, and gaining a thorough understanding of client requirements and company information, in order to manage the pest problem. The selection of appropriate equipment, pesticides and methods is essential for performing the task safely and efficiently.

Maintaining a storage area requires the ability to follow established procedures, understand the issues associated with the storage and use of pesticides, and adhere to legislative and public health and safety requirements. These work functions would be carried out according to company guidelines. This course specifies the outcomes required to maintain a pest management vehicle storage space for pest management equipment and pesticides. It also covers the movement and control of equipment and pesticides used in the provision of pest management services.

The course supports pest management technicians responsible for applying pesticides that may affect public health, work health and safety, and the amenity of the community and the environment. It supports pest management technicians responsible for ensuring that pest management equipment and pesticides are stored, transported and controlled according to legislative requirements; in particular health and safety environmental safety and public health and safety. It applies to maintaining and operating a safe and efficient pest management storage area within a strict legislative context.

This course also includes the completion of the Termite Treatment for Power Poles Course.

PREREQUISITES

Participants are to be medically fit to handle registered pesticides and must be over 18 years of age.

DELIVERY

THREE FULL DAY COURSE

This program combines face to face training involving small group activities, workplace projects, homework and revision questions.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

A pest management operator who undertakes pest management treatments for remuneration must be licensed in accordance with the Health (Pesticides) Regulations 2011.

Occupational Health & Safety Legislation is very specific in respect to the duties of both employers and employees when it comes to general Duty of Care.

So who should attend?

- Western Power Employees and Contractors who apply chemical to;
- Kill live termites seen attacking power poles.
 - Kill live termite nests in close proximity to power poles, and
 - Protect power poles from potential termite attack.
